Suzanne is a Nationally Certified Street Manager through the National Trust for Historic Preservation's Main Street Center. For the past three and a half years she has been the Western Region Program Services Coordinator for the Pennsylvania Downtown Center, providing outreach, technical assistance and training to communities and managers in the Main Street and Elm Street programs, funded by the Department of Community and Economic Development.

Prior to that, Suzanne served in a dual role as the first Main Street Manager and the Executive Director of the Washington Business District Authority in downtown Washington, PA for four and a half years. During that time, she was actively involved in the city's 14 block streetscape project, helped establish a Farmers' Market, and was a founding board member of the Washington Community Arts and Cultural Center.

Suzanne's work in downtown and neighborhood revitalization and her background in business and economic development make her a welcome addition to the Community Revitalization team at the Northwest Commission.

The Gagliardos relocated from Pittsburgh to Oil City in November 2007.
